Dear Global 19th Century Conference Participants,

We are truly excited about the advent of “The Global 19c: Contiguities. Connections. Detachments” taking place at UC, Riverside on February 25th and 26th, and we are looking forward to meeting you and hearing your presentations.

In order to make everything run as smoothly as possible, we need to address just a few logistical concerns.

For those of you staying at the Mission Inn the night of Tuesday, February 24th, a shuttle to campus will pick you up in front of the Inn between 8:30-45 on Wednesday morning. We will return you to the Mission Inn after the last session.

Please let me (Renee) know if you will need to be on the shuttle.

Those of you driving in the morning of the 25th, or who choose to drive from the Mission Inn, the program will begin at 9:30. You may park in Parking Lot 1 on the UCR campus. This is the lot nearest the University Avenue entrance to campus. When you arrive, follow the signs to parking lot 1. The parking attendant in the lot will direct you. Parking is free for conference guests.

Do let Renee know if you plan to drive to campus.

In order to transition more easily from speaker to speaker during panel sessions, we will load your presentation onto the computer (from a thumb drive). This will reduce the need to connect different computers between talks and should allow things to move more smoothly. We will have thumb drives available for your presentations, but you may also wish to provide your own.

We will be able to accommodate those of you working in Keynote rather than Powerpoint, but do let us know your preference and any special audio-visual needs you may have.

Also, as reminder that we will be digitally capturing your presentations for later internet broadcast. Please let us know if you would prefer not to be recorded.
